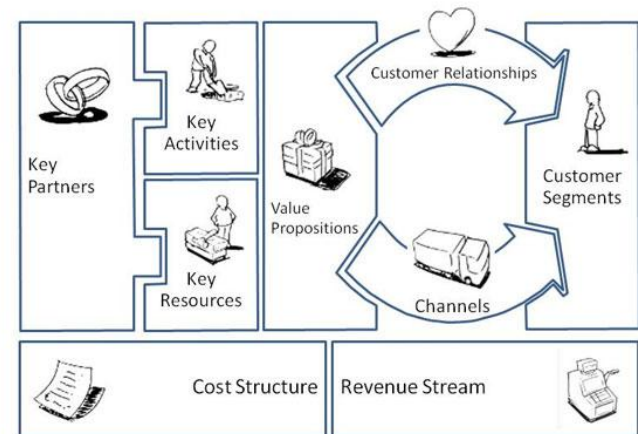

Objective



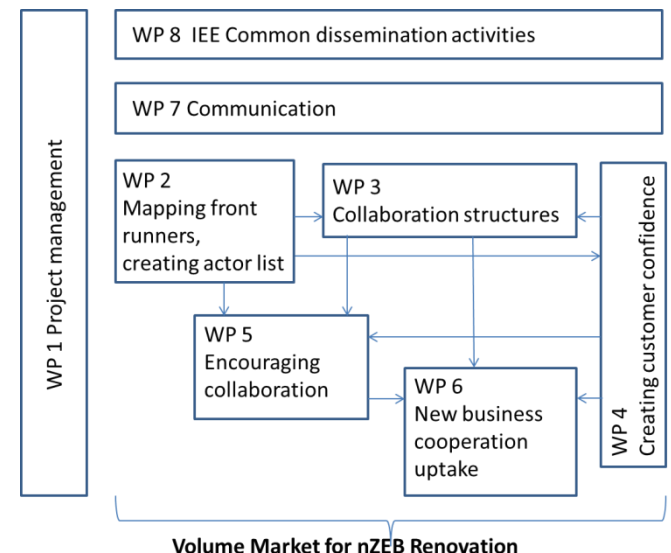
